# Learn More about NCMA's Contract Management Leadership Development Program (CMLDP)

NCMA designed the Contract Management Leadership Development Program (CMLDP) to help develop the next generation of contract management leaders. Each spring, NCMA selects a limited number of CMLDP applicants to participate in the yearlong educational experience. Successful applicants have between 4-8 years of contract management experience, a bachelor's degree, and an employer recommendation. The CMLDP curriculum is intense-participants attend webinars, complete various assignments and projects, travel to conferences, and finish a graduate-level research paper. Although the level of effort is high, CMLDP graduates benefit immensely from the knowledge, mentorship, and professional connections they get from the program.

The Denver Chapter has a proud tradition of members successfully applying for and completing the CMLDP. A few years ago, we asked one of the Denver Chapter CMLDP graduates about the benefits this individual personally experienced from participating in the program. She replied:

"The short list: a network that stretches across the country, confidence as a leader, and opportunities to work with a world-wide professional organization. The network gained from the program is so much larger than your graduating class. Upon entry into the program, you become a part of the graduation network that spans 10 years and over 200 graduates. Yet you are still one of the elite when you walk across that stage and this is recognized by employers and other NCMA members.

"I can't quite put into words the value of that network and the feeling that you have a friend at every national event and support if you relocate, have to find a new job, etc. What's more is that students come from industry and government-we have an unprecedented opportunity to learn from each other and then have connections to ask questions later in our careers. Talk about breaking down communication barriers between government and industry-this program helps tie us together."

If you generally fit the criteria for admission to the CMLDP and the benefits of the program interest you, we encourage you to learn more and consider apply for the 2019-2020 CMLDP program.
