Alert - OFCCP No Longer Sending Written Notice of Audits

The Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs (OFCCP) announced that it will no longer send companies a written notice of a pending audit. Companies must check the online Corporate Scheduling Announcement List (CSAL) on the OFCCP FOIA Library in order to learn if it will be audited. OFCCP also encourages companies to subscribe to OFCCP Email Updates through its website to receive timely notification of the CSAL and other compliance assistance resources real-time.
